No meetings, just reminders! In the job description of Eucharistic Ministry an annual meeting can be held. I hope this newsletter will suffice instead of a meeting. Some review and reminders:

ALL cups and plates should be rinsed with water so that any remaining residue/particles of the consecrated wine and bread is removed from the vessels. The water should be poured down the small round sink (sacrarium) in the sacristy. This sink drains directly into the ground, thus avoiding the pipe/sewage system. They can then be washed in the sink with soap and warm water in the work area.

ALL (adults as well as children) who come forward with their arms crossed over their chest, should be given a **BLESSING**. Simply place your hand on their head and say, "God be with you" or "make a Sign of the Cross" on the person's forehead" and say the same. This same Blessing should be given to **ALL** infants and toddlers who come forward with an adult. Nos. 6 and 11 ONLY need to be attentive to this.

Please plan to attend the Morning of Reflection, this Saturday morning, November 12th, beginning with 8:30 Mass.
